- A) Bret Afdahl called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m.
- B) Present at the Meeting were Public Deposit Protection Commission Members Bret Afdahl, Director of Banking and Rich Sattgast, State Treasurer. Also present were John Crompton, Deputy Director of Banking, Brock Jensen, Counsel for Banking, Marianne Gabriel, Supervisor of Banking for the State Treasurer, Marsha Karst, Senior Secretary for Banking, Curt Everson, President of the South Dakota Bankers Association and Bob Mercer, Capital Journal Reporter.
- C) Legislation/Administrative Rule Change to remove lines 6a, 6b, 7a, 7b from the SD Public Depository Liability Return. Curt Everson shared thoughts from his Membership about the removal of lines 6 and 7 from the quarterly form.

Motion: Sattgast moved to proceed with the removal of lines 6 & 7 which will require changes to certain administrative rules in ARSD 6:02:02, 2nd by Afdahl.

Approved by the following Action 2-0 (Afdahl & Sattgast)

- D) Certificates of Deposit as eligible collateral to secure public deposits. Curt Everson expressed the need to clean up language in existing statutes and asked the Commission to consider adding certificates of deposit to the definition of eligible collateral that can be pledged to secure public deposits.

Motion: Afdahl moved to support legislation and Sattgast seconded the motion.

Approved by the following Action 2-0 (Afdahl & Sattgast)

Curt Everson will draft the bill on behalf of the industry for review by the Commission. The outcome of the legislation will determine when the Commission can schedule a public meeting to proceed with Administrative Rule Changes. The Division of Banking will take the lead on the Administrative Rule process.

E) Adjourn the meeting

Motion: Sattgast moved to adjourn, 2nd Afdahl.
